Temporary Closure of: A429 M4 Roundabout Junction 17 (Part), Stanton St Quintin and Temporary introduction of 40mph Speed Limit: Various Roads, Stanton St Quintin and Kington Langley (Ref: TTRO 9424)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to:

Close temporarily to all traffic:

A) **A429 M4 Roundabout Junction 17 (Part), Stanton St Quintin**; from its junction with M4 Junction 17 to Junction 18 On Slip to its junction with M4 Junction 17 from Junction 18 Off Slip.

And to temporarily introduce a 40mph speed restriction on the following lengths of roads:

- B) **A350 Northbound (Part), Kington Langley**; from its junction with A429 M4 Roundabout Junction 17 for a distance of approximately 800m in a southerly direction.
- C) A429 M4 Roundabout Junction 17, Stanton St Quintin and Kington Langley; for the complete length of gyratory.
- D) A429 Junction 17 of the M4 north to Junction of Church Lane (Part), Stanton St Quintin; from its junction with A429 M4 Roundabout Junction 17 for a distance of approximately 200m in a northerly direction.

To enable: National Highways to carry out resurfacing of the West Bridge deck, PTSI works on the East and West bridge decks and associated works.

Alternative route: via A350 – A4 – A3102 – B4042 – A429.

The closure, speed restrictions and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic lights.

This Order will come into operation on 29 April 2024 and will be required until 12 July 2024. The closure will be required on 14 June 2024 between the hours of 19:00 and 06:00 until 17 June 2024 and will also be required on 28 June 2024 between the hours of 19:00 and 06:00 until 01 July 2024. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
